MESSAGE TO MEMBERS

At our annual meeting, a member shared her experience of witnessing funds being withdrawn from her account while viewing through online banking. Being resourceful, she figured out how to lock her debit card down and stop the malicious activity before causing further issues. This member's experience suggests our need to inform members of the many controls you can and probably should put into place on your accounts.

ENROLL IN TEXT BANKING

Text banking allows you to request account information via text, as well as to receive important information about your account via text. You can enroll by selecting *Text Banking* under the *Featured Services* tab in the top left corner of online banking.

ENROLL IN E-ALERTS

e-Alerts are notifications for account activity that is important to you... such as monitoring account balances, verifying transaction amounts, receiving loan payment reminders, and more. Activate e-Alerts through either online banking or the mobile app, where you can choose whether to receive notifications via secure message center, email and/or text message.

ENROLL IN ACTIVITY ALERTS

Enable Activity Alerts through the Manage My Cards icon in the Affinity mobile app to stay up to date on purchases and monitor possible fraudulent activity. You'll receive text notifications any time your Affinity debit or credit card is used to perform a transaction.

While I'm suggesting things that individual members can and should do to protect their money, the credit union continuously invests in information security, prevention of cyber-security threats and overall security. The evolution of threats is concerning and with the expectation of instant access 24/7, we take extraordinary measures to protect the members and assets of the credit union. 

These thieves and vandals netted zero dollars from their three heists but created a lot of frustration for members and management. We've taken significant measures to deter our ATMs and buildings from being targeted but we cannot control the decision making of a criminal.

Make sure to keep in mind that we are members of the Shazam Privileged Status network, meaning that there are hundreds of surcharge-free ATMs in the Greater Des Moines area, as well as statewide, where members can withdraw cash for free.
